

Harmonizing our spiritual with creation communicates and influences an ever larger circle as we deepen our path. Sages influence even those not on the path to care for the Earth Interbeing in the ways of the spirit, but it takes a great sage to reach the deeply selfish and hostile. All respond to such a sage because its influence opens the way for everyone.

The mutuality of love within Earth Interbeing knows no separation from the ways of the spirit. Sages communicate sweetly and caringly to other beings and respond well to myriad situations. The power of love can transform a whole realm. Love establishes the foundation of trust necessary to create the new era.

Line 1: The line has a strong resolve to have a spiritual path and understands that the path has many challenges and dangers. At the beginning of complete trust and faith in the path, the wise carefully consider what they believe, aware that putting faith in untrustworthy beliefs and assumptions leads to regret. Once they have faith in the path, then they can commit and proceed.

Line 2: Having a deep harmony between spirit and being resonates with others open to the spirit, the echo awakened in the hearts of others through spiritual attraction. A sincere feeling voiced with truth and clarity or deeds that clearly manifest the ways of the spirit have a far-reaching influence. At first such an influence acts on the inwardly receptive, but the circle grows larger and larger.

Line 3: Its reaction to external events constantly toss the line to and fro, preventing it from resting within the spirit. When it experiences life going its way, it feels joy but despairs when its feels blocked by circumstances. This describes those who depend on life always meeting their expectations and not the behavior of wise people.

Line 4: Just as the moon receives light from the sun, the line receive wisdom from the spirit. Just as the moon not yet full remains open to more light, the wise remain open to more wisdom. The line appropriately follows the wise and loses relationships with those not on a spiritual path. The sage journeys through life like a horse that bears the its burden of responsibilities without concern whether others do the same.

Line 5: Only the sage can bring together and support an external interbeing of those who share the same path with the Earth Interbeing through the power of its virtues. Without the openness and devotion of a sage to the spiritual path, the heart wavers.

Line 6: The line wants to soar to the highest spiritual realm, but it cannot. Its words fly upward, but its actions do not follow. This line marks the end of harmony with the spirit. Those who count on mere words to awaken the faith of others may succeed now and then, but they will have cause for regret if they persist in this manner.
